



Safer At Home

St. Johns County

To further combat the spread of COVID-19, Governor Ron DeSantis has issued a Executive Order 20-91, a Safer at Home order directing the State of Florida to shelter at home and limit movements outside of their homes beyond essential needs.

✓ **YOU CAN:**

- Go to the grocery, convenience, warehouse, or hardware store.
- Go to the pharmacy to pick up medications or other healthcare essentials
- Go to a restaurant to get take out, delivery, or drive thru
- Go for a run, take a walk, ride your bike, enjoy a hike, and be outdoors while maintaining 6 feet between you and others.
- Walk your pets and take them to the vet if necessary.
- Care or support a friend or family member
- Help someone to get necessary supplies
- Receive deliveries from any business which delivers

✗ **DON'T:**

- Go to work unless you are providing an essential service as defined by this order
- Visit friends and family unless there is an urgent need
- Maintain less than 6 feet from others when you go out
- Visit loved ones in the hospital nursing homes, skilled nursing facilities or other residential care facilities except for limited exceptions as provided on the facilities website.
- Do not rent short term vacation properties, not to include motels, hotels or long term properties until May 1

What does Safer at Home mean?

- Stay at home, unexposed and do not expose others
- Only go out for essential services
- Stay 6 feet or more away from others.
- Do not gather in groups
